This program brings Adult Basic Education and University Transfer courses directly into the Mowachaht/Muchalaht First Nation community. Learners can strengthen essential academic skills, meet entry requirements for future studies, and begin exploring university-level pathways—all without having to leave home.

With a focus on **Indigenous Leadership, Tourism Management, and Business Administration**, the program is designed to support both individual goals and the broader aspirations of the community. Courses are delivered in partnership with **North Island College (NIC)** and emphasize accessible, culturally grounded learning.

Students will:

- Build confidence in reading, writing, and math while preparing for further studies
- Earn credits that can be transferred into university programs
- Explore career pathways in leadership, tourism, and business
- Learn in a supportive, community-based environment that values cultural connection

This program isn't just about upgrading, it's about creating opportunities for long-term educational success, career growth, and economic empowerment rooted in place and community.

The Haa'yuu Learning Pathways will be delivered digitally. Digital classes will be delivered via Kaltura, a videoconferencing platform. Students will need to have access to a computer/laptop with internet access. The instructors may discuss other videoconferencing platforms on the first day.
