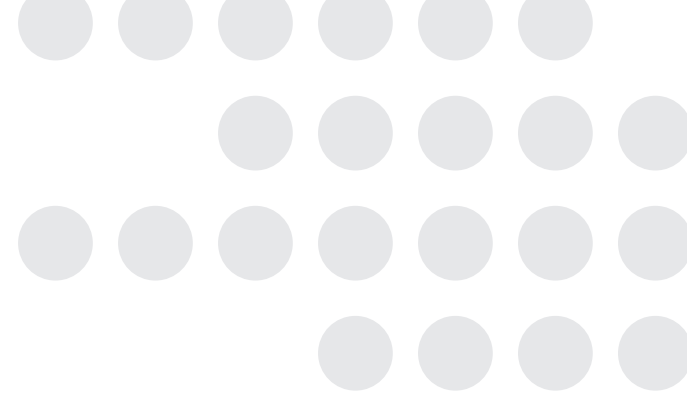

As conversations around Indigenous lands and property transactions continue to grow, it's essential that Indigenous REALTORS® are empowered to lead, serve, and benefit from the opportunities within their own communities. We've created this scholarship program to help with that.

WHAT THE SCHOLARSHIP OFFERS

With support from the Real Estate Foundation of BC, we have created a fund to help Indigenous individuals begin a career in real estate.

Each scholarship covers the full cost of becoming licensed, including the:

- UBC Sauder Real Estate Trading Services Licensing Course;
- required textbook
- licensing exam; and
- licence fee.

Additional supports may be available based on individual need.





SUPPORTING INDIGENOUS VOICES IN REAL ESTATE ON VANCOUVER ISLAND

WHO CAN APPLY?

This scholarship is open to anyone who:

- is Indigenous; **and**
- either lives in the VIREB region **OR** belongs to an Indigenous nation whose territory is within the VIREB region.

Whether you're a recent graduate, mid-career learner, or someone exploring a new path, we encourage you to apply.

HOW TO APPLY

Applicants are asked to submit:

- a brief statement of interest;
- one letter of reference; and
- proof of connection to an Indigenous community.

Applications can be sent to education@vireb.com and will be reviewed quarterly by an anonymous selection committee. There is no limit to the number of scholarships awarded each quarter; funding is available until the annual program budget is reached..
